

All the bearings are Magnetic.

The Latitude is 35° 20' S.  
The Longitude is 145° E.

High water E & Cin [Appar. Sound - II. 20] Springs rise 3 to 4 feet  
Hobson Bay - III. 0

The tides height and strength of the tides are much influenced  
by the wind outside. In the entrance they run from 4 to 7 knots,  
in the channels from 2 to 3, and in the bay are very feeble.
