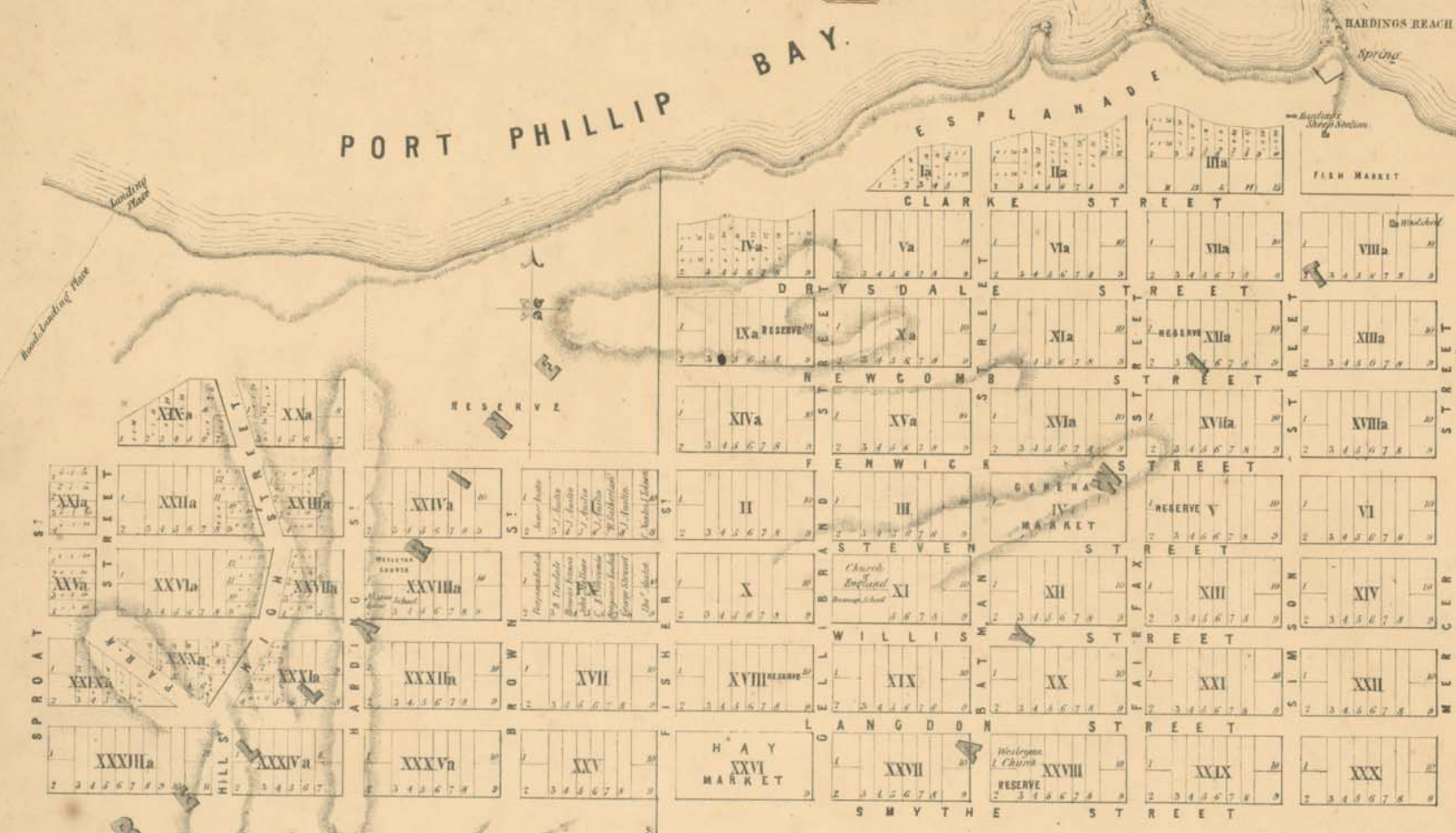


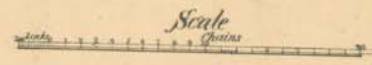

Note. All the Allotments where not otherwise specified contain half an acre. Water is procurable by sinking along the coast and a large permanent supply may be obtained with a little labour from the extensive marshes situated about a mile to the eastward of the township. The soil on the site of the township is generally black loam moderately timbered with well grown trees of gum, the Oak, Lightwood, and manna.
